Birthday bash in Orangeville Saturday

Orangeville will be celebrating its 150th birthday Saturday with an all-day street celebration, and a plethora of vendors, games and attractions along the town's main street.

More than 90 stalls and food trucks will be serving burgers, pancakes, sausages and more, starting with a free community breakfast at 8:30 a.m. and lunch from 11 a.m. to 2 p.m. which will be organized and set up by the Enbridge community events team. A beer garden, featuring the brews of Orangeville-based Hockley Valley Brewing Co. will be situated on Broadway, close to the intersection of Second Street.
