

David Tilson highlights Canada's assumption of Arctic Council chair

Dufferin-Caledon MP David Tilson recently rose in the House of Commons to pay tribute to Health Minister Leona Aglukkaq, MP for Nunavut, as the incoming Chair of the Arctic Council.
