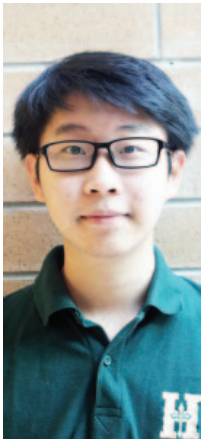


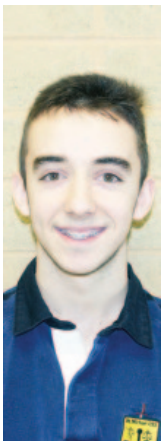
DQ Athletes of the Week ?April 21, 2015
