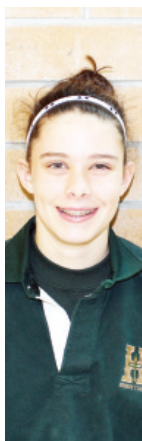


DQ Athletes of the Week ? February 19, 2015
