

Education Minister Stephen Lecce vows to 'keep kids safe' upon return to school

As students prepare to get back to school, teachers and parents are a bit apprehensive about what to expect.

Ontario's Education Minister Stephen Lecce said Ontario's plan to reopen schools is the 'strongest in Canada.' Ontario has the most comprehensive masking policy, and the government has provided more funding for cleaning, testing and staffing.

'We will continue to keep students safe,' he said.
