

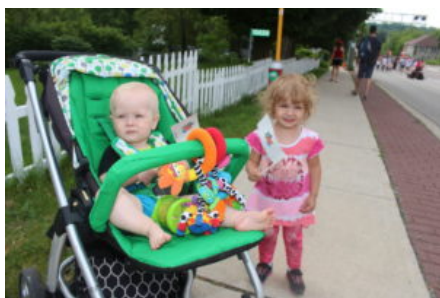
It was a fun time at Inglewood Day



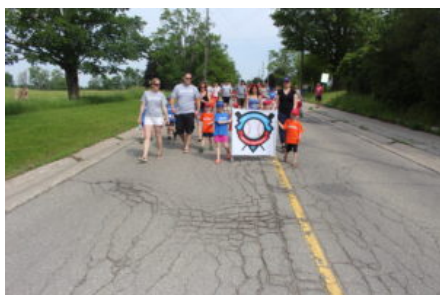
