

Market relocated to increase community vitality

The Bolton Farmers' Market, formerly known as the Caledon Farmers' Market, is moving to Mill Street, Bolton. The market opens this Saturday (June 14) and will operate every Saturday, from 9 a.m. to 1 p.m., until October. The opening day party will include family activities and games, as well as live music, crafts and, of course, food. A section of Mill Street will be closed to traffic between Queen and Chapel Streets every Saturday until Oct. 11.
