Missing man is safe

The Ontario Provincial Police (OPP) Criminal Investigation Branch has confirmed a 36-year-old Cheltenham man has been located and is safe.

Sukhpal (a.k.a. Pauly) Pannu had been the subject of a police search after he had left his residence the evening of Dec. 19 in an unknown vehicle. His whereabouts were confirmed Wednesday (Dec. 24).

Police still want to speak with a second man considered missing from Peel Regional Police jurisdiction, who may have direct knowledge of the circumstances of Pannu's disappearance.

37-year-old Rajman Grewal or Mangat is described by Peel Regional Police as South Asian, standing six feet tall, weighing 190 pounds with wavy, black hair and brown eyes. He has a light beard and a thin, black moustache. He was last seen around 6 p.m. Dec. 19 wearing a grey sweat suit.
