

Relevance of church to be explored at Lifetree Café

The relevance and viability of church will be discussed at Lifetree Café this coming Wednesday (Nov. 6).

The program, entitled *Is Church Obsolete: Has God Left the Building?*, will explore emerging trends that point to the church losing membership and eroding in influence.
