

Speeding driver charged

A 47-year-old man from Orangeville has been charged with speeding and alcohol related offences after an incident last Monday morning (April 13).

Caledon OPP reports an officer was conducted speed enforcement on Airport Road, south of Old School Road and saw a silver Dodge Caravan pass a group of vehicles in the northbound lane. The Dodge was clocked going 160 km-h un a posted 80 zone. The officer stopped the vehicle, and upon speaking to the driver, noticed a strong smell of alcohol. The driver failed the breath test he was given and was charged with driving with more than the legal limit of alcohol in his system, as well as stunt driving. His licence was suspended for 90 days and the vehicle was impounded for seven days.
