Learn about bird migration and spring baby animals. Make your own pine cone bird feeder to attract birds in your garden at home.

Hear expert gardening advice and receive information about how to get ready for spring. Enjoy wagon rides, live entertainment and more.

Admission is free for conservation area members. Non-members pay \$8 for adults, \$5 for children four to 12 years old and seniors over 60 years. Children under four are free.

Visitors should be prepared for the weather, because the event runs rain, snow or sunshine.
