

Test drive a Ford Saturday

Ford dealerships across Canada, including Bolton's Fines Ford Lincoln, will be hosting the innovative Drive 4UR School program this Saturday (May 7).

This is in an effort to raise funds for Free The Children.

For every person who test drives a Ford vehicle at Fines Ford Lincoln (10 Simona Dr.) in Bolton between 10 a.m. and 4 p.m., Ford of Canada will donate \$20 toward a country in greatest need of education, clean water and sanitation, agriculture and food security, health or alternative income and livelihood. Free The Children was selected by the students at Allan Drive Middle School.
