'Grades 5 to 8 is what we are targeting? once they get to high school, there's more social opportunities. But this is an age group that is underserved,' said Martins.

Fines said she and Martins wanted to support the Caledon Hawks because they are a Caledon-wide organization with deep roots in the community.

Martins said 100 per cent of ticket sales will be going to the Caledon Hawks, and there will be a concession stand with proceeds being donated too.

'We're covering all of the costs of the event,' said Martins. 'It's a great opportunity for kids to have a fun time, and at the same time, 100 per cent of the funds are going to a worthwhile organization.'

Martins and Fines said Party Rockers Entertainment puts on a great party, complete with video screens, a light show, live DJing, and more.
